
Archive Of Back Issues

Prophecy Fulfilled

We believe that the words of the Prophet Haggai are being fulfilled in our lifetime; "This is what the Lord Almighty says: in a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. I will shake all nations, and the desired of all nations will come, and I will fill this house with glory, says the Lord Almighty" (Haggai 2.6–7).

This prophecy is repeated in the New Testament where it was still pointing to a future event at the end of the first century A.D when the book of Hebrews was written. It says, "Now he has promised, once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens. The words once more indicate the removing of what cannot be shaken – that is, created things – so that what cannot be shaken may remain. Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire" (Hebrews 12.26–29).


Prophecy Today aims to present historical, sociological and theological articles and papers that bring a biblical perspective upon world events.

Warning Signs

Many observers of the world scene, especially financial experts, believe we are heading for some kind of catastrophic event that will shake the whole of our civilisation.

Strangely enough that is exactly what the Bible prophesies. But the Bible also offers some alternative scenarios, because God is a merciful God who promises: "If at any time I announce that a nation or kingdom is to be uprooted, torn down and destroyed, and if that nation I warned repents of its evil, then I will relent and not inflict on it the disaster I had planned" (Jeremiah 18.7).

There is still time for repentance and turning onto another path. *Prophecy Today* will point the way. "Ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls" (Jeremiah 6.16).



Management

Prophecy Today will have an Editorial Board who pray with their eyes open and their spiritual antenna raised high to check for danger and to pick up signs from God.

Blind LEADING Blind

Is new Labour getting guidance from witchcraft?

Clifford Hill charts the growth of "government by appearances"

Prophets have never been popular with political or religious leaders. Their mission has always been to challenge the ungodly. Throughout the life of this magazine we have attempted to stand in this tradition. We do not claim always to get it right because we are fallible human beings. But our objective is to seek the word of God for our times rather than the opinions of men and women, of which there is a super abundance in the media. We keep a watch on what is happening in Britain, in Europe, and on the international scene. We bring this before God seeking to know what he is saying in these circumstances.

I am saying these things because in this issue we have some strong words for the British Government and we wish our new readers to understand that we do not speak from a party political platform. Our objective is to bring the word of God to whichever political party is in power. Readers who were with us throughout the Thatcher and Major years will know the truth of this!

New Labour came to power in Britain five years ago on a huge wave of popular support and great expectations. The British people were promised that a new era was beginning in open, clean, democratic government that would be in sharp contrast to the sleaze-ridden outgoing government under the previous administration. Tony Blair came with a fresh, clean, safe-married-man image and a churchgoing background. The Government's mandate was renewed with another massive parliamentary majority last year, but since then things have begun to go wrong.

Great power has led to an arrogance and a disdain of parliamentary democracy. A fresh clean image of 'open government' has been badly tarnished by one revelation after another of what is going on behind-the-scenes. Instead of openness there have been cover-ups, botched attempts to bury bad news, manipulation of public opinion, false information leaked to the press, and misinformation designed to undermine the credibility of those who oppose government policy or even dare to question it!

What has been coming out of Whitehall has been a tangled web of intrigue, of lies, deception, and petty infighting. All this has been an attempt to centralise power, to minimise opposition and to undermine the normal processes of democracy. The outcome is that backbenchers on all sides of the house feel powerless and unable to fulfil the task for which they were elected – to serve the best interests of the people and to ensure their welfare and the maintenance of their rights and privileges....

The Prime Minister leads a UK Government that uses an expert on Pagan witchcraft to advise on appointments to Government posts. I want to remind our Mr Blair that in spiritual matters you cannot serve two masters. If you dabble in witchcraft you automatically cut yourself off from God. When King Saul was desperate for guidance and went to see the Witch of Endor, the result was that God tore the kingdom out of his hand (1 Samuel 28). The plain fact is that the UK Government is being driven by powerful spiritual forces of evil and that they are not even aware that they are dicing with death.
